Maryland's First Lady exhibits this summer

Marylanders know her as their state's First Lady, wife of Governor Larry Hogan. Many do not know that Yumi Hogan is also an accomplished artist. The Art League of Ocean City is proud to be devoting the Thaler Gallery to her work during July and August 2017.

Hogan's exhibition, entitled "Nature's Rhythmic Alliance," will showcase her abstract landscape paintings produced in Sumi ink on Korean Hanji paper, acrylic, and Asian techniques.

The South Korean-born Hogan met her husband at an art show in Columbia, Md. She received her BFA from the Maryland Institute College of Art, and her MFA from American University. Hogan has had more than 14 solo exhibitions and was part of a 2017 group show at the National Museum of Women in the Arts.

Hogan teaches as an adjunct faculty member at her MICA alma mater and plans to support the arts community and social issues such as those affecting single mothers.



Art Can Clean Beaches

We are so proud that the Ocean City Council has approved our pilot program to paint beach trashcans with eye-catching anti-litter messages.

The "Art Can Clean Beaches" program was originally developed by the Green Team as a way to remind beachgoers that trash belongs in the receptacles and not in the sand. Then they gave us the reins to implement the project.

The Art League received a \$5,000 grant to print vinyl wraps through the Maryland Environmental Trust's "Clean up, Green up Maryland" fund. Sponsorships cost \$260 per can or \$750 for three cans, with \$10 of each going to future beach cleanup efforts. Since we are nonprofit, they are tax deductible.
