ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- All media accepted (hand-drawn, computer generated, crafts, etc)
- Maximum size is 18 x 24" and **artwork must be ready to hang.**
- Entries **must** have a 3x5 index card attached to the front with the following information: **Artist's name, age, grade, school, artwork title, and medium.**
- Artwork must be created in the past year and never before entered in an ALOC show.
- Fan art acceptable but not eligible for grand prizes.
- Must be presented in a way that is appropriate for the school setting and for children to view.
- Artwork will be included at the discretion of the exhibit committee, as space allows.

CASH PRIZES! Awarded on the basis of creativity, originality, and artistic merit. Awards will be given for top entries from each division as well as certain Grand Prizes, if merited, in the categories: Best in Show, Best 3D Submission, Best Animation, and Best Original Composition. Judge: University of Maryland Eastern Shore professor Brad Hudson.
