Our festival stands to unite artists with their audiences and allow for an intimate and unique festival experience that can only be found in Ocean City. Our second year will feature more than 100 films from local filmmakers and from the other side of the planet.

Categories include feature films, not short/ not feature length films, plus shorts focusing on youth, animation, horror, documentary, music videos, humor, drama, social commentar and experimental, as well as music videos.



In that time we have served over 80,000 visitors who have enjoyed the many exhibits, classes, and events. Our membership has grown to almost 1,000 artists and art lovers, finding connection to others who share their interests.

This January, we welcome the 4th annual "Shared Visions" collaboration, where member artists interpret the writings of the Ocean City Library Writer's Group. February brings the Eastern Shore painting legend Willie Crockett here for a watercolor workshop and an evening of poetry and story.

The 2nd annual Ocean City Film Festival returns March 9-11, featuring over 100 original films in a variety of genres at venues throughout the resort. Then on March 17-18, we welcome back Brown Box Theatre Project for a thrilling live performance of "Hotel Nepenthe"- not to be missed.

In this newsletter, you will find dozens of classes for kids and adults, geared to all levels, allowing absolute beginners and experienced artists the chance to express themselves creatively.

Not only have we expanded programming in the building, our outreach efforts with Worcester County Schools and collaborations with other nonprofits have also grown over the past five years. 
