## Lecture: The Fire at Notre Dame: Past & Future

### **WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 16, 6 - 8 PM**




As a fundraiser for the Art League and in celebration of Ocean City's History Week, architectural historian Robert M. Craig will present an illustrated lecture on the fire at Notre Dame Cathedral, discussing the significant features of the building over time including past mutilations and desecrations. A highlight will be a review of proposals by 21st century architects to rebuild/redesign the roof and spire after the April fire.

Dr. Craig is Professor Emeritus of Georgia Tech's architecture school where he taught from 1973-2011. He has lectured around the world and authored nine books, including two illustrated histories of the Ocean City Beach Patrol.
