

In January of 2017 I was very fortunate to establish a relationship with the Art League of Ocean City and begin

planning the Ocean City Film Festival. Over the past few years, we have seen unprecedented growth in our festival operation.

When we began the Film Festival, my first goal was to create an outlet for local filmmakers to share their work. Film festivals are few and far between in our region, and in establishing ourselves as Ocean City's official Film Festival, we have awoken a vast collective of local talent that did not previously have access to a movie screen or networking opportunities in town.

New festival seasons bring new films, new stories, and new artists. 2019 was a landmark year for us as we were greeted with record audience numbers. Following the 2019 festival, we were also ranked in the Top 100 Best-Reviewed Festivals on Filmfreeway.

March 5th through 8th of 2020 will be four days of creative celebration. In our fourth season we are featuring panels with industry professionals, 12 different categories of films, bigger parties, new venues, and even more to be announced!




