We are having fun and making a difference.

A aintaining tradition is vital in troubled times, and we are creating new ones as we adapt to circumstance and continue to support our constituency. We are especially proud of our outreach to youth, providing free online classes, free art supplies through the Worcester Public Schools, a recent month-long "OC Memories" art contest, and much more.
