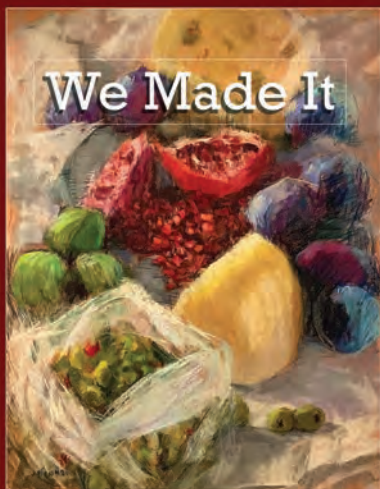

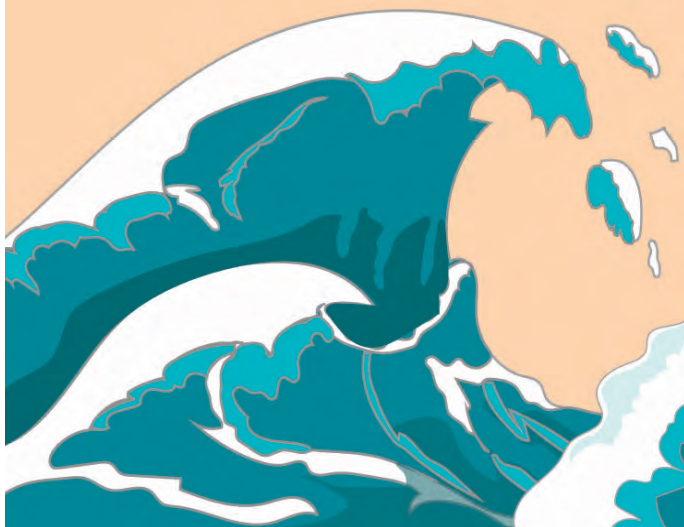

HARRIET'S CRAB DIP

This crab dip recipe was my mother's who learned it from her mother, so it's been a family staple for holiday gatherings for as long as I can remember. It is quite simply the best I've had and many others agree! I have many requests to serve this at parties where the recipe is always requested. Bon appetit!

INGREDIENTS

1 stick butter
2 Box, packages cream cheese
2 tsp. Worcestershire sauce
1 Tbsp. lemon juice
1 Tbsp. chopped chives
1 Tbsp. chopped parsley
Old Bay seasoning to taste
1-2 lbs. crabmeat

DIRECTIONS

Preheat oven to 350°. Melt butter and cream cheese in a saucepan, and whisk until creamy. Add all other ingredients and blend. Fold in crabmeat. Bake in oven until hot and bubbly. Best if made one day before planning to serve.



LAURA JENKINS, HERE COMES THE SUN

I have come to love and enjoy painting the beautiful indigenous landscape of the Eastern Shore of Maryland, where I am so fortunate to live. Born and raised here, the ocean and the marsh lands have been engrained in me and are frequently the subject of my work. I find they bring me peace...

GREEK STUFFED PEPPERS

A family favorite. The stuffing can also be used for grape leaves and other vegetables. Back in the Bronx, NY, my mother, my aunts, and myself would sit around the kitchen table and roll grape leaves, and solve all the problems of the world. Later my daughter joined in, and now my granddaughter. Stuffed peppers, called "dolmades", are faster than making the stuffed grape leaves, called "dolmades", but just as tasty.

INGREDIENTS

6 large bell peppers
½ lb. ground beef
½ lb. ground pork
½ cup Carolina rice
½ cup each, fresh parsley and dill
¼ cup mint
1 bunch chopped scallions
½ stick unsalted melted butter
½ cup extra virgin olive oil
Juice of one lemon
1½ cups diced small ripe tomatoes or 1 can petite diced tomatoes, chopped up more
2 cloves finely minced garlic
1 tsp. ground cumin
Salt and pepper to taste

DIRECTIONS

Seed peppers and save caps. Mix all ingredients together and stuff peppers. Do not overfill - leave room for the rice to expand. Place stuffed peppers in a large pot. Cover each pepper with its top, and pour about 1 cup of water or vegetable broth on top. Drizzle a healthy amount of olive oil on top, about 3 Tbsp. or more. Bring to a boil, then quickly reduce heat to a low simmer. Cover pot completely, and simmer for an hour or until fork tender. Remove from heat, and let sit for at least 15 minutes. Serves 6. Serve hot or warm.
