





We are seeking nominations for the 4th Annual SHEro Awards 2021, honoring Delmarva women who have shown courage in facing adversity and turned that around into something positive. Nomination deadline is Oct. 8, 4 p.m. and nomination forms are available on our website.

Candidates for the SHEro Awards must be 18 years or older and residents of Delmarva, but they do not have to be related to the arts. Past SHEros have included women who are mothers, teachers, volunteers, community organizers, caregivers, nurturers, and business leaders. Some have faced health challenges or worked three jobs to support their families. Some have volunteered their time and talents or championed a worthy cause.

"We all know someone who is a SHEro. We are asking you to help us find them," Rina Thaler, executive director of the Art League, said. "By sharing the stories of women who do so much, we hope to inspire others. And we want to simply acknowledge everything that women do in their lives that often goes unnoticed."

Thaler emphasized the SHEro Awards are not a competition. "All SHEros who are nominated will be recognized at our awards ceremony on Friday, Oct. 29," she said.

We will present the SHEro Awards free in-person at the Arts Center on Friday, Oct. 29, 5-7 p.m. All are welcome.





#### MAKING ART FUN & ACCESSIBLE

s we fall into autumn, I wanted to take a moment to reflect on what was the busiest and most challenging summer we have experienced in the nine years we have been in the "new" building.

Over five weeks, we welcomed nearly 200 children to our art adventure camp. Never before have we had such a demand for camp, and we turned away almost as many campers as we accommodated. The campers were so



happy to be able express themselves and meet new friends after a year of limited socialization. Special visits from local authors, illustrators, and a special sculpture project with Professor Bill Wolff of Salisbury University (our 2021 Orem & Harriet Robinson Fellow for Contemporary Art and Community

Engagement) made it memorable. We are grateful to the volunteers, many first-timers, who turned out to help, and the excellent teachers and counselors brought to us by a grant from the Donnie Williams foundation.

We then welcomed 50 artists to our annual Artist Paint OC Plein Air event. The artists painted more than 200 works, each capturing a moment in time, and took home \$5,500 in prizes, including a \$2,500 first prize by the Peter Glenville Foundation. We sold 46 works of art for more than \$20,000 during the event.

The next weekend, we were at Art X at Northside Park. A collaboration of the Town of Ocean City and the Art League, thousands of people turned out despite the weather. We offered hands-on workshops in pour painting, wine glass painting, shell mosaics, fish stamping, tie dye T-shirts, chalk art, youth plein air, and geocaching, plus demonstrations, screenings of films from our OC Film Festival, a quick paint event, and beer and wine sales.

A six-session summer outreach program at Buckingham Elementary led by artist Carol Rydel allowed the children to participate in an art enrichment program. A record number of students took classes in pottery and other mediums here at the Arts Center in July and August. The Art League conducted 94 classes – both in-person and online – with 713 students attending.

We reached our goal of 1,100 members (bringing us back to pre-Covid levels) with our summer membership drive, thanks to the donation of the limited edition, hand-signed Patrick Henry prints that new and renewing members received. (We have a limited number of these still available and will end the membership drive when they are gone.)

I want to commend our team - staff, board members, instructors, and volunteers ¬- who worked diligently to put on the events this summer, and thank all who participated in our classes, purchased artwork, or supported us in any way.


