Studio E hosts the "Stigma Highlighted - Portraits of Recovery" exhibit. This visual art project – a massive collaboration between the Art League and Worcester Goes Purple – challenges the misconceptions and negativity towards individuals battling addiction. Twelve participants from four Lower Shore counties who have experienced recovery were paired with twelve artists who painted their portraits while listening to their stories. Bonds were formed, and the artwork created was made even more dramatic by video footage filmed of the interviews. The resulting exhibit is one of the most powerful expressions of art and hope we have ever produced, and we encourage you to experience it.

The Stigma project will be traveling to recovery events around the Shore, as well as to area high schools, where we will show a 15-minute documentary featuring the stories of recovery. We are also grateful to the Giving Spirits Foundation, Worcester County Health Department, and Talbot Goes Purple for their support.

We are now seeking your help to help us create a full-length documentary on the topic. The film will be featured at the 2023 Ocean City Film Festival, and submitted to other film festivals. Please let us know if you are interested in supporting this effort.

Also in October (check our website for details): Join us for our "Sunday Soirée" on Oct. 9 to celebrate the arts and honor the homeowners and sponsors of the Sand Castle Home Tour.
