

PROVIDING ACCESS

his year 2022 has been both challenging for the Art League as we continue to navigate through the effects of COVID, and also gratifying as we provided more access to the arts than ever before. But what exactly does providing access mean?


Providing access means allowing people of all ages to create art, appreciate art, collect art, and engage with the arts, whether it's our camp kids working with

college professors to create sun prints or hosting free gallery visits by assisted living residents.

Providing access means meeting people where they are, and that is why our exhibits extend beyond our building to places like the Coffee Beanery and Princess Royale Hotel and also on utility boxes, visitor center walls, and area tennis court fences.

Providing access means removing barriers of cost by offering free admission to the Arts Center and no-cost programs like Free Family Art Days, HeART & Soul, lectures, gallery tours, summer Saturday craft days, and bringing 1,200 Worcester County students together for a free performance of Artrageous.

Providing access means collaborating with other nonprofits like Worcester County Developmental Center and Worcester County Youth and Family Counseling to offer opportunities for people with disabilities and those in at-risk situations and raise awareness of difficult topics. Our "Stigma Highlighted" program gave a platform for survivors of addiction to tell their stories and share how young people can avoid drugs and alcohol in documentary video. This program paired artists with the survivors to create portraits of addiction recovery in an exhibit that will continue to travel and inform.



As we look to 2023, the Art League will be celebrating the 60th anniversary of our founding and the 10-year anniversary of the opening of our home, the Ocean City Center for the Arts. We will be looking back at where we have come from and also looking ahead to remain a vital part of your future. Please consider a donation to our end-of-year annual campaign.
