



Application for the Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Fellowship

The Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) Fellowship creates an organizational culture that aligns with our core values of respect, integrity, creativity, excellence, and empowerment.

The fellow provides their input for programs and practices to better promote DEI by engaging with the board, reviewing internal and external communication, and participating in staff meetings and Art League events.

By constructing activities and events that stimulate conversation around diversity in the community, they help to encourage inclusivity.

Working with the Executive Director, the DEI fellow develops new programs for otherwise under-represented communities. These classes, workshops, and events give everyone an opportunity to participate in what the Art League has to offer.

The position is granted to an artist annually, and the information about the fellow including bio and image will be included on our website and in our publications. A \$1,500 stipend is awarded to the artist-fellow, along with a one-year membership in the Art League along with complimentary invitations to Art League of Ocean City ticketed events. The position is designed to enhance and provide growth for both the artist-fellow and the Art League of Ocean City.

1. RESUME/CONTACT

Please provide a full resume with contact information and a complete list of your relevant experiences.

2. SUMMARY OF EXPERIENCE

After reading the position description, summarize your experience as an artist, arts professional, and/or educator that would make you a good fit for the fellowship position.

3. FELLOWSHIP VISION

What special areas of interest or expertise would you emphasize in your role as Fellow for Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion. While it may not be possible at this early stage to pinpoint precisely what you would do, share your initial vision for how you see yourself in the role. What would you like to accomplish and what form would your involvement take? You should include what benefits you see for yourself and your professional development in the fellowship.
