Recently I received an email from an Art League member who shared a clip from the CBS Sunday Morning show with a note that said, “Thought you would enjoy seeing this.” The video was from a segment with 87-year-old Jane Fonda where she shared the secret to aging well, including having a good attitude and finding community.
