The mission of the Art League of Ocean City (ALOC) is to promote artistic expression and appreciation for the creative arts in our community.

AWARDS: Applicants may be considered for the "Sidney M. Beckstead" (\$5,000), "Katherine Ellen Brown" (\$1,000 up to 3 scholarships), "Eva Fox" (\$1,000), "Inga Tuveson" (\$1,000), and "Macon Katherine Chandler" (\$1,000), "Jim Adcock" (\$1,000), "Vera Cross" (\$1,000), "Schwab Family" (\$1,000) scholarships. Scholarship winners will also receive a 1-year membership to the Art League of Ocean City. Awards will be given at the June First Friday opening reception and scholarship winners are required to attend.

ELIGIBILITY: The Art League of Ocean City's scholarships are available to graduating high school seniors who are **residents of Worcester County, MD** (including public and private schools and homeschooling). Scholarships are also available to past Art League of Ocean City scholarship students continuing their education who are in good standing with a grade point average of 3.0 or higher. Scholarship recipients must be pursuing a higher education degree or career in the visual or performing arts.

SELECTION PROCESS: The applicant must complete this application and submit it to the school's guidance counselor or the Art League of Ocean City by **April 15th** to be eligible for consideration along with 3 digital images of his/her portfolio, two current letters of recommendation (one from a teacher and a personal recommendation from a non-family member) and a copy of the school's official transcript signed by the school's guidance counselor. All images including artwork, letters, and transcripts must be submitted in a JPEG or PDF format. Submissions sent by mail should include a flash drive with digital images.

Qualifying candidates will be interviewed by an Art League of Ocean City Scholarship Committee who will take into consideration the applicant's goals, scholarship, citizenship, academic awards, extra-curricular activities, motivation and skills. Please ensure the email address and phone number are correct.
